

## CHM1190Y Analytical Chemistry Seminar Course Outline, 2017-18

**Course Description:** The analytical chemistry seminar series provides graduate students with the opportunity to learn about a wide range of analytical chemistry topics. Seminars are given by scientific leaders in the field as well as by Ph.D. students in the Analytical stream (often, but not always, in years 2 and 4 of their work), and the topics presented vary each year. All students in the Analytical stream are expected to attend the seminars (with exceptions for unavoidable conflicts, including TAing, illness, and field trials, etc.).

**Location and Time:** All “regular” chm1190 seminars are held in the Davenport seminar room on Thursdays from 11AM-noon. Each regular seminar will be video-cast to the Mississauga (room DV3138) and Scarborough (room EV502) campuses. There are also some “irregular” seminars that may be of particular interest to analytical students (fall-term irregular seminars are listed in gray); it is understood that some students will not be able to attend the irregular seminars.

**Analytical Seminar Points (ASPs).** After each seminar, the instructor will post ASP questions on portal (including instructions for submitting responses). Ph.D. students in the Analytical stream are required to earn 30 ASPs prior to graduation. **Note: it is not expected every student will respond to every ASP;** rather, instructors endeavor to offer as many sets of ASP questions as possible to enable each student to have as many possible opportunities as possible to earn the requisite 30.
