Course Description: The environmental chemistry seminar series provides graduate students with the opportunity to learn about a wide range of environmental chemistry topics. Seminars are given by scientific leaders in environmental chemistry and the topics presented will vary every academic year. The seminar series will also serve as a forum for MSc students to present their exit seminar (typically in year 2 of their program) and for PhD students to present their proposals (typically in year 2 of their program). Students are also expected to attend environmental chemistry-sponsored Departmental Colloquia. Seminars from other chemistry disciplines, such as relevant Chemistry Colloquia and seminars, and other programs will also be recommended.

Course Evaluation: Students will be evaluated on a pass or fail basis. This evaluation is determined based on student participation in seminars. All graduate students are required to attend seminars regularly and ask questions. The course co-ordinators will monitor attendance and participation by graduate students.
